This year the Tiger Dublin Fringe celebrates 21 years of innovation, imagination and risk taking with what promises to be one pretty spectacular festival. Running from September 7th till September 20th the Tiger Dublin Fringe brings everything to the table. Dance, theatre, cabaret, circus, carnival, comedy, music and live art, served both indoors and out, all are included in all their glory, along with the welcome return of the Spiegeltent.

Once again, this year features a generous blend of Irish and international performances. Australian circus legends *Scotch & Soda* are notable highlights, as is the Tony-nominated *Mx Justin Vivian Bond*. Other highlights include Kim Noble's *You're Not Alone, Grounded* by Siren productions, *It Folds* by Brokentalkers and junk ensemble and Irish Youth Opera's production of *Agrippina*. Potential hidden gems include Liadain Herriott with *Liminal*, featuring as part of a double bill along with Emma Fitzgerald and Antje O'Toole with *Tend*. Herriott's excellent *TURF* was one of last year's surprises, as was yeahsurewhatever's *An Insignificant Man*, who also return this year with *No Encore*.
