Gare St Lazare Ireland bring Beckett to New York

Following on from their recent performances of “Waiting For Godot” and “The End,” acclaimed Beckett interpreters Gare St Lazare Ireland conclude their time in New York with the US premiere of “Here All Night.” A new theatrical work for soprano and actor, “Here All Night” is based on extracts from Beckett’s novel “Watt” as well as his poems and texts and runs at The Lincoln Center, White Light Festival on November 5th, 6th and 7th.

Led by Conor Lovett and director Judy Hegarty Lovett, Gare St Lazare Ireland have made a mission of exploring Beckett’s prose works over eighteen years and have toured to over twenty five countries. With “Here All Night” Gare St Lazare Ireland present a music and text piece created by the company with musician Caoimhin O’Raghallaigh and UK composer Paul Clark. “Here all Night” features Melanie Pappenheim (Dr. Dee) as solo soprano and is comprised of texts, songs and music by Beckett himself, with original compositions by Clark and “The Gloaming’s” Caoimhin O’Raghallaigh.

Regarded by many as the foremost Beckett performer, Conor Lovett has played over eighteen Beckett roles to date. In 2014 he won the prestigious Stage Award for Acting Excellence at

Edinburgh, and both he and Judy Hegarty Lovett were off-West End Award nominees for “First Love” in London last year. As Ireland’s most travelled theatre company they are no strangers to New York and have previously performed at Signature Theatre, The Public Theatre and The Irish Arts Center. The company have toured Ireland eleven times since 1998 and have become synonymous with Beckett’s writing.

“Here All Night” produced by Gare St Lazare Ireland, with the support of Culture Ireland, runs at The Lincoln Center, White Light Festival on November 5th, 6th and 7th. Show begins at 7.30 p.m.
