Irreverent, blasphemous, brilliant, this Irish duo, demonstrating their own unique brand of musical comedy, show no respect for political correctness. And Amen to them for that.

Covering all the big misses from their album *Sing-a-long with Mammy*, in *Totally Wired! Reunion Farewell (Welfare) Tour - A Sperm's Tail and Other Tales*, the boys deliver an hour long set of jokes and songs that are as deranged as they are hysterical. You simply won't be able to help yourself singing out loud to many of their classics like *Sex Face* and *Gay Best Friend*. With *Totally Wired!
